FROM THE WEBMINISTER



Good tidings to you from the land of 1's and 0's!

It's been a busy month for the Sternfeld website. I completed a review of the entire site, and made many minor changes and edits throughout. I also worked my way through the file structure of the site, and have archived off all the old pages and versions of the site that are no longer in use. I am also pleased to announce that The Sternfeld Star is now available on the web going back to November. A huge thank you to Lady Odile for getting the permissions needed from article submitters! I know it was quite an undertaking.

research on the archery techniques used in period. Those who receive this award become Companions of the Order of the Greenwood Company, and though they may use the title The Honorable Lord or Lady, as any other person of Grant-level rank, they are often called by the alternate title "Forester" instead. They are equal in precedence to those who have received the Evergreen, Gold Mace, Bronze Ring, and White Lance. They are higher in precedence than those with a simple Grant of Arms, and lower than those who have received a Dragon's Heart. Their badge, as shown above, is a fieldless trio of green evergreen trees, with a golden arrow barb superimposed in the center. Additionally, Foresters of the Greenwood Company frequently show their affiliation (especially in court) by wearing green hoods with red and white striped trim resembling the Midrealm pale around the openings.

In August, we will discuss the awards that are given for dedicated service: the Purple Fret, the Dragon's Heart, and, of course, the Pelican.





## MIDDLE KINGDOM AWARDS - ARCHERY

Target archery is a popular activity within the Middle Kingdom, and there are several awards which may be given specifically for this activity.

First of these is the Dragon's Barb. It is given "to individuals who, in the sight of the Crown, have shown proficiency on the field of archery or exemplary service in furthering such field (*MK Law XVII-802*)." You may notice that the wording of the qualification is much like the wording for the first rapier combat award, and in fact this award is equal in precedence to the Cavendish Knot, the Red Company, and the White Chamfron. It holds a rank higher in precedence than the Order of the Gaping Wound, but lower than the Purple Fret, King's Chalice, and Doe's Grace. If one has not already received an Award of Arms upon receiving it, one is considered armigerous. Like the similar awards in other fields, it focuses on solid but perhaps not extraordinary skill, and also great service in the field of archery in specific. There are several awards given for general service (we will discuss those next month), but service can also be a component towards receiving awards focused on particular activities. Those who receive the Dragon's Barb are generally called Lord or Lady, though they can more formally be styled 'Companion of the Order of the Dragon's Barb.' There are no particular customs of dress for those with this award, though of course they are entitled to wear the badge shown above at their discretion. This badge features a green scaled tail inside a scaled ring, with no background color specified.



There is also a Grant-level award for Archery which can be given in the Middle Kingdom: this is called the Greenwood Company. It is given to "individuals who, in the sight of the crown, have shown excellence in two of three areas of archery: skill, service, and the arts and sciences (*MK Law XVII-1402*)." Because this is a

higher-level award, much higher amounts of skill and service are expected of the individual who receives this award, besides which they are also expected to know some things about arts and science in an archery-related capacity – for example, they may carve bows or fletch arrows, or have done

At the June business meeting, I proposed a podcast be started and posted to the site, covering topics of interest to people in the SCA. After some discussion, the general consensus was that it could be an interesting idea. A premiere episode of the concept is under development and will likely be released in August. Master Johann has graciously agreed to be my test subject. In the meantime, I'm looking for people to come forward who are willing to be interviewed about their Craft or Skill, or who wish to talk about their persona within the Society (either in character or out), for future editions of the podcast.
