Pennsic is just around the corner.....er...planning for Pennsic is just around the corner!

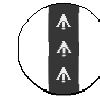
Please remember that you have until the middle of June to get registered to camp with a group for Pennsic. If you don't register by mid-June, this means that you will most likely be camping at the far ends of the earth with no camp mates for support in some left over corner of Pennsic. This is true for any camp, whether Baronial or household. To register, go to www.pennsicwar.org and follow the directions.

Sternfeld does have a Baronial camp at war that is open to all Sternfeld members, along with many guests from outside of the Barony who we love to catch up with every year at war. If you have camped with Sternfeld before, just register as usual and drop me a line when you get your confirmation so that I can check to make sure that they filed you in the correct place. If you have not camped with the Barony before, please contact me so that I can fill you in on how the encampment works. We have a few rules that make it easier to live with each other (most people, upon reading them for the first time, remark that they are just common sense, but we like to be clear in case the sense isn't as common.) We do charge a daily camp fee which covers items such as firewood, propane to heat your dishwater and shower water, citronella oil to burn in the centralized tiki torches and bottled drinking water.
