



## November Business Meeting Minutes

### **Baron & Baroness:**

The Baroness reports that a batch of the Sternfeld coins has arrived, as was ordered. The court list for Try Something New is being finalized. Please make award recommendations via the Sternfeld Website!

### **Seneschal:**

The Althing is Sunday, November 18th from 1PM-6PM at the Chase Legacy Center; officers please get with Kat on any needs for Althing discussions. Kat would like to have a report from all officers for the Althing, especially major officers. Kat would like a yearly budget from each office. Share a treat or donate to St. Timothy's food bank.

### **Herald:**

Currently working second shift. Nothing to report currently. Officially has a voice deputy: Colette.

### **Chronicler:**

Working on November issue of the Star.

### **Exchequer:**

As of end of October, we have \$15,479.81. Quarterly reports have been submitted. The exchequer is still working to get the information for financial committee members to be submitted so we are in compliance. The quarterly numbers that we got from Kingdom actually matches what we have, for the first time in a long time, possibly ever! We have a new regional exchequer and a semi-new kingdom exchequer. We need to order checks - we have less than 100 remaining.

### **Marshal (Heavy):**

Last month, \$100 was passed for new armor. Ulfr still needs to spend it. Attendance is up - the gym is getting crowded which is absolutely a good thing!

### **Fencing:**

Doing well. Domesday made it in on time. We have 11 fencing marshals in the Barony! Plus one in training!

### **Archery:**

Eadric reports that attendance is pretty steady. They are looking forward to BWTA.

### **Youth:**

Haven't practiced recently. Inventory is done. Wishlist coming together in the next few days.

### **Chirurgeon:**

Nothing to report. We may have a new person working on getting warranted!

### **MoAS:**

No report this week.

*Costumers:*

Doing a show-and-tell event at the Try Something New event. Also offering garb construction help and gothic fitted dress fittings.

*Brewers:*

People are Brewing and Vinting and Cordialing. Ronan is teaching a class on it at Try Something New.

*Cooking:*

Will not meet this week but due to the Althing, will not be meeting this month.

*Ars Rustica:*

No report. We do still have lots of chickens.

*Performance Arts:*

No report.

*Largesse:*

Will meet in January after the holidays. Will be putting pins and needles in sewing kits. Maybe in January at the Yule event.

**Lesser Offices:**

*Chatelaine:*

Is still looking for a deputy. Has been absent and busy. She did submit her report to Kingdom. Gold Key needs inventory.

*Minister of Youth:*

Needs help for events. Needs some firm commitments. Needs to still do property inventory of the Youth Property.

*Property Master:*

We have stuff. Lots of it. 22 Pages Worth! That's just the storage and trailer, not stuff officers have. Officers need to provide a list of their Baronial Property. Only the Youth Combat Marshal has done so up to this point. (The Web Minister would like to inform the Property Master that he does not have any property.)

*Prize Czar:*

The prize czar is planning on spending her budget to get some more prizes. If you want prizes at an event you are running, please contact the prize czar to request which prizes you think would be appropriate!

*Web Minister:*

We have a website. Sites exist for "Try Something New". The Yule site will go up as soon as information is provided. The site for BWTA is in process and will be going live within the next week, in all likelihood. Officers were given instructions and information on their new [sternfeld.org](http://sternfeld.org) accounts, which provide email and google docs accounts for all major and minor officers plus autocrats for all events we run! Email addresses will be updated on the web in the next week or so, per agreement of the officers present. I want these tools to work well for the Barony!

### **Events Updates:**

*Try Something New* - December 1st: There are tons of classes (62 by this author's count). This will be a really different event, and there's a lot of enthusiasm and energy behind it! We need to be offsite on time, as we are charged by the hour. We have 8 tracks of classes, in four rooms plus the gym will be divided into four classrooms. *Yule* - January 5th: Website coming soon. Event will run from 10 AM to 9 PM. Wulfwen will be smoking meat for the event. Remainder of food will be pitch-in. There will be a cooking competition as well. Court and Golden Tower meeting will happen.

*BWTA* - February 16th to 17th: First ad will be in the December Pale. Talking to department heads. Getting information. The archery schedule is together. Bead Rescue Project will be there. Site tokens to be ordered soon.

*Baronial Birthday* - Bids are Open for this Event (June 2013). Crickets were heard on this topic. Please submit a bid if you are considering it!

*Simple Day* - Waldetrudis is currently looking for sites. Waldetrudis is down to two choices: The FFA Center (Same as Previous Two Years), and Johnson County (Same as Many Previous Years). Discussion of the benefits and problems with both sites has been discussed. In either case, a Tavern-Style Feast would be the feast and a feastocrat has been found. We'll be discussing this at the Althing Sunday - please consider the options. A quick polling indicates that FFA Center is the better option, but more discussion will need to happen.

*Event Discussion* - A rewrite of the rules in the bylaws regarding events is being discussed. We'll be discussing this in more detail at the Althing.

*Krannert Park* - We'll be setting up a contract for 2013 with the park for use of the space. We pay \$25 an hour, for two hours each Tuesday for the gym rental for fighter practice. (We don't pay for 52 weeks - as we are outside for a chunk of the year.) We are looking at the option of offering classes at/during fighter practice to try and make our group more appealing to the Park Management. These classes would be things we could teach to the public.

# Althing Meeting Minutes

## Overall:

Drafts of changes to the Baronial Bylaws and Baronial Financial policy were distributed. A copy of these policies will be edited with changes discussed at this meeting - these revised documents will be posted to the website and to the Sternfeld list, as well in the Sternfeld Star. These policy changes will be voted on at the next two business meetings, so there is opportunity to suggest changes between this meeting and the next two business meetings. Polling on the finalized versions of these documents is planned for December and January.

## Financial Policy:

Our Exchequer (Elisabetta) presented the Financial Policy for the Barony. Discussion occurred regarding how the signatories (other than the Exchequer, Seneschal, and Regional Exchequer) are changed out. Do they need to be changed regularly? What are the criteria?

The outgoing Exchequer will not be retained as a signatory.

After discussion it was decided that an announcements page will be made on the website to post weekly announcements, including any financial decisions over \$100, in addition to announcing them at a weekly meeting. When possible, these financial decisions will be published in the Star as well.

Article 7 Section 7.05 was proposed to be stricken from the Bylaws, as the same policy is covered in the financial policy. Proposed wording was discussed. (This is Financial Policy 2e.) Wording will be drafted.

There is a form for all reimbursements or advances. It will be made available via the website along with other financial policies and forms.

## Bylaws Revisions:

Throughout the bylaws, wherever the Star is mentioned as a place to publish information, the website will be added as well. Additionally, locations in the bylaws where financial policies are dictated will be removed, with a reference to the Financial Policies document.

## (Article VI) Champions:

- Strike the phrase "No Champion may compete to succeed him or herself." from Section 6.02.
- Strike the phrase ", once in the month preceding the Baronial Birthday and once in the month preceding the Baronial Holiday Court." from Section 6.03 This is to allow flexibility in scheduling the changes of champions.
- Strike the same phrase in the previous item from 6.04 as well.
- Strike the phrase "at the Better War Through Archery event, or another event chosen by the Coronet," from 6.05.
- (The preceding 3 changes are for the same reason.)
- Change "according to the A&S criteria of the Middle Kingdom and the wishes of the Coronet." to "according to the wishes of the Coronet." from 6.06.
- Also change 6.06 to remove "and judged at the Baronial Birthday".
- Also change 6.06 to remove "and the current A&S Champion" and replace with "and others invited by the Coronet."

**(Article VII) Events:**

Discussion of how to word and or change 7.01 "The Barony shall hold a maximum of three (3) large events per calendar year." A rewording is due from the people working on it by December 13th.

- 7.01.a Strike "1st quarter of the year" to remove the required date range to allow it to happen at other times when needed.
- 7.01.c Strike that item entirely. It's an optional event.
- 7.01.c.i Strike entirely.
- 7.01.c.ii Strike entirely - due to more hotels having been built around Indianapolis, the Indy 500 makes it no longer a problem to hold events that weekend.
