

We'll be spinning into a slower season for local events soon, so I'll have more time to work on other web projects as I can identify them. The sternfeld.org domain has been obtained for our use, and we are in the process of transferring the domain from the donator (Lord Ronan Keith) to the Barony's control. You'll notice that if you go to sternfeld.org in your web browser, it redirects you to our website on midrealm.org. We do not have plans to change hosting - the domain will be useful as a shortcut to get to our website without typing in the entire www.midrealm.org/sternfeld/ address. Though we are not hosting on the Sternfeld.org domain directly, having the domain enables us to do some neat things.

Relating to this: we will be doing a pilot program soon to provide email addresses (@sternfeld.org) to several officers in the group. We can provide up to 10 email addresses for free via Google Apps for Domains. If this pilot program is successful, we'll be looking to add additional addresses (at a low yearly cost, possibly free) such that all local offices have their own email address. These addresses will also be useful in providing continuity when offices change ownership - we can provide continuity of email between the old and new officer, which is especially useful for new officers looking to understand decisions that were made historically.

September Business Meeting Minutes

Overall:

Drafts of changes to the Baronial Bylaws and Baronial Financial policy were distributed. A copy of these policies will be edited with changes discussed at this meeting - these revised documents will be posted to the website and to the Sternfeld list, as well in the Sternfeld Star. These policy changes will be voted on at the next two business meetings, so there is opportunity to suggest changes between this meeting and the next two business meetings. Polling on the finalized versions of these documents is planned for December and January.

Financial Policy:

Our Exchequer (Elisabetta) presented the Financial Policy for the Barony. Discussion occurred regarding how the signatories (other than the Exchequer, Seneschal, and Regional Exchequer) are changed out. Do they need to be changed regularly? What are the criteria?

The outgoing Exchequer will not be retained as a signatory.

After discussion it was decided that an announcements page will be made on the website to post weekly announcements, including any financial decisions over \$100, in addition to announcing them at a weekly meeting. When possible, these financial decisions will be published in the Star as well.

Article 7 Section 7.05 was proposed to be stricken from the Bylaws, as the same policy is covered in the financial policy. Proposed wording was discussed. (This is Financial Policy 2e.) Wording will be drafted.

There is a form for all reimbursements or advances. It will be made available via the website along with other financial policies and forms.

Bylaws Revisions:

Throughout the bylaws, wherever the Star is mentioned as a place to publish information, the website will be added as well. Additionally, locations in the bylaws where financial policies are dictated will be removed, with a reference to the Financial Policies document.

(Article VI) Champions:

Strike the phrase "No Champion may compete to succeed him or herself." from Section 6.02.

Strike the phrase ", once in the month preceding the Baronial Birthday and once in the month preceding the Baronial Holiday Court." from Section 6.03 This is to allow flexibility in scheduling the changes of champions.

Strike the same phrase in the previous item from 6.04 as well.

Strike the phrase "at the Better War Through Archery event, or another event chosen by the Coronet," from 6.05.

(The preceding 3 changes are for the same reason.)

Change "according to the A&S criteria of the Middle Kingdom and the wishes of the Coronet." to "according to the wishes of the Coronet." from 6.06.

Also change 6.06 to remove "and judged at the Baronial Birthday".

Also change 6.06 to remove "and the current A&S Champion" and replace with "and others invited by the Coronet."

(Article VII) Events:

Discussion of how to word and or change 7.01 "The Barony shall hold a maximum of three (3) large events per calendar year." A rewording is due from the people working on it by December 13th.

7.01.a Strike "1st quarter of the year" to remove the required date range to allow it to happen at other times when needed.

7.01.c Strike that item entirely. It's an optional event.

7.01.c.i Strike entirely.

7.01.c.ii Strike entirely - due to more hotels having been built around Indianapolis, the Indy 500 makes it no longer a problem to hold events that weekend.

Were passed on first polling (will poll again at December 2012 Business Meeting).

October Business Meeting Minutes

Baron & Baroness:

The baronial coronets are back! Gold sapphires were no longer available; the missing stones were replaced with amber.

Everything seems to be going well; activity level is high.

A baronial court was opened. Belden was called into court. An Award of Arms was bestowed from TRM Savaric and Juliana, which has originally been awarded at Simple Day this year. The court was closed.

Seneschal:

Althing is 18-Nov-2012 from 1:00-6:00 at the Chase Legacy Center. All officers should give Kat a full report, and if they cannot make the meeting, please send a deputy to make your report. Directions will be posted on the Sternfeld site.

Herald:

Moira mentioned that Llewellyn is now working second shift.

Chronicler:

Brigitte said that the month of September was a blur with work. She is working on The Star. It should be complete by the weekend.

Chronicler has requested that a reminder be set up on the Yahoo! Group for Officers to submit reports for The Star. Eirik will set this up.

Exchequer:

Elizabetta mentioned we are doing a full inventory. Anyone who has baronial property in your possession, please add that information to the Inventory Google Doc or send the information to Elizabetta.

- Quarterly report due at the end of this month, and will be submitted on time.
- Bank balance is \$16,592.06 as of the end of September.
- There will be a good deal of financial discussion at the Althing. Anyone with budget needs for 2013, please bring as much detail as possible so we can start planning.

Marshall, Heavy:

Per Ulfr, three or four new people have started fighting. This means we no longer have enough loaner gear. The most urgent needs are for elbows, knees and gauntlets. Many of our elbows and knees are wearing out, and we just don't have enough total sets.

There was some discussion about whether it would be more affordable to make or buy loaner gear.

Moira suggested that Ulfr organize an armoring class for Try Something New, with the goal of getting some items completed. There was enthusiastic agreement. Ulfr will assemble information about whether the project will need funding.

Wulfwen moved to fund \$100, so that it can be passed before the event. Motion passed and Elizabetta will get a check to Ulfr.

Marshall, Fence:

Fencing is going well.

Bjorn is cleaning up the fencing roster. Some new people have started fencing.

In other fencing news, Rurik announced that Torquil was second in the rapier championship at Rendezvous. He will be representing Constellation at KWAR. Elizabetta mentioned that Rurik was the champion, and will also represent the Region at KWAR.

Marshall, Archery:

Kat mentioned that the archers are still getting 12-14 people at practices.

Moira asked Kat to ask Eadric to see whether an archer could come to meetings as a deputy.

Marshall, Youth:

Rois will be putting together a wish list and budget for Althing, to replace some of the worn out youth gear.

Moira asked whether Rois needs money to replace items before Try Something New. Rois said she will do some calculations and let the group know.

Chirurgeon:

The Chirurgeon had nothing to report; she sent this via Kat.

A&S:

Kat asked Duncan if he had anything from Johann. Duncan said no.

Odile said she needs the A&S report; Duncan asked her to copy him on the request.

Costumers':

The most recent meeting turned into an embellishment/knitting meeting.

Brewers' & Vintners':

Ronan reported that there haven't been any meetings in some time.

Brigitte asked whether there would be any classes coming up. Ronan will be teaching Basic Cordials at Try Something New.

Cooks':

Brigitte reported that Cooks' had a trip to Jungle Jim's last month; it was awesome! It will probably become a semi-annual trip.

Cooks' and Bards' meets Sunday at Grainne's house. Bring a dish for the pitch-in.

Ars Rustica:

No report.

Performing Arts:

Kat reported that Colette taught a class at Garfield Park. It was extremely well attended.

Largesse League:

Elizabetta said they met in September and started several pouches.

Saturday they are meeting at St. Timothy's at noon for a class on making needles and pins.

If you can make it, please bring a non-perishable food item for the church. Please also consider bringing some gas money for the teachers; they are passing the hat.

Chatelaine:

Austorga is looking for a deputy. For now, she just needs help; it is possible she will need to step down in the next six to eight months.

If you took any Gold Key Garb to repair, please get it back to Austorga as soon as possible, so that she can have it ready for Try Something New.

Kat mentioned that Sternfeld is doing extremely well at attracting and retaining newcomers, especially compared to other local groups.

Moira said two things we do very well is: we have lots of activities, and we don't bicker.

Minister of Youth:

Emme wasn't present. Kat said she is looking for donations of supplies; contact Emme if you can help.

Property Master:

Ronan reported that Inventory Day went well. We now know what we have and how much it weighs, so we know what can safely be transported on the trailer.

Kat received the notification that the trailer is legally registered. Elizabetta and Ronan asked for copies, and an extra to put on the trailer door.

We're still discussing building tent pole racks in the trailer. Ronan will bring the budget to Althing.

Prize Czar:

Grainne picked up the prize stash from Kat.

Web Minister:

Antonio sent a report. We have a website!

Try Something New:

Torquil asked whether there were any plans for a Novice Tourney. Consensus was not so far.

Moira said the plans are going well. Rois mailed the check and contract to the site.

Classes are starting to fill up; if you're interested in teaching, contact Moira, Rois or Llewellyn. We can really use classes on personal development and history.

There will be a Baronial Court at the event; please send in award recommendations!

Grainne will be handling the volunteers for the event, particularly for the high-volume areas.

Tear-down will have to be done very quickly, so that we can vacate the site.

Rois is working with the marshals and related classes.

Yule:

Odile said plans are proceeding.

Odile has talked with Wulfwen about smoking the meat that the barony will be providing.

Kat said we need to do one more polling for the budget. The total budget is \$400, with the plan to donate any leftover money to St. Timothy's for their food pantry. Budget was passed.

BWTA:

Austorga has requested a certificate of insurance for the site. Corporate will send it as soon as the 2013 policy is finalized.

The Pale ad has been submitted. We will be running two ads, so Austorga needs a check for the second ad.

Moira asked whether the budget had already been passed; Kat and Austorga confirmed that it had.

Kat asked how the Regional A&S activities are going. Odile said that we are on the A&S Faire Schedule, so everything is going fine.

Kat asked how the archery activites are shaping up. Austorga needs to talk with Eadric and find out.

Baronial Birthday:

Kat announced that bids are open.

Simple Day 2013:

Kat said Waldetrudis is still looking for a site. She is revisiting Johnson County; they have done some construction, including a new kitchen.

Moira asked whether anyone was familiar with the State parks in Crawfordsville. Kat asked anyone with site leads to send the information to Moira, Waldetrudis and her.

General News:

Kat stated that the Barony is considering changing the Bylaws to reflect a more flexible stand on whether and when to hold events.

Wulfwen & Rois announced that al-Jafar is looking to put in a bid for Spring Crown and A&S 2013. The site Rois found is the Hamilton County 4H Fairgrounds, which is in Sternfeld. Does anyone have objections to al-Jafar using the site? After some bantering discussion, it was agreed that there was no objection from Sternfeld.
