

## December Business Meeting Minutes

**Barony of Sternfeld - Business Meeting - 12/19/2013**

**Baron & Baroness:** We still have a Barony. The heavy and fencing champions changed over. Michael de Quarmby and Rurik the Red are our new champions, starting at Yule Court.

**Great Officers and their Deputies:**

**Seneschal:** We need a backup key holder for opening St. Timothy's in case Ysabel cannot be at meetings. If interested, please talk to Ysabel.

**Chatelaine:** No report this month.

**Herald:** People have been consulting on names and devices. Several submissions bounced and are being revised. Fabric was done for tabards. No further update on the tabard project at this time. People have come up with ideas for badges for awards - hoping to move forward with developing badges for awards that do not have any.

**Chronicler:** December Star was published by Antonio, who is now officially a deputy Chronicler. Will publish in January if Ambrosia has not returned from out of state.

**Exchequer:** We have \$17,727.44 in the bank currently. No activities since October, so no substantial financial stuff has happened recently. Will be writing insurance checks for BWTA tonight. No funds requests for Yule or BWTA have come through yet. A deputy has approached. Domesday is due at the end of January. Elisabetta welcomes people to come see how to process works and will post information online about when she will be there. Looking to create a database of previous event information (attendance, costs, etc).

A motion for a 9' X 30' to be purchased for \$419.99 from 3 Rivers Archery was raised, seconded, and carried.

**Equestrian:** Had a November Practice. Did Tippet Tag. There is no January practice. Toula and Michael de Quarmby are Equestrian MITs now.

**Chirurgeon:** No report. No recent injuries.

**Arts and Sciences:** Read his letter in the Star. It would help him greatly if people would send recommendations for Artisan of the Month.

**Ars Rustica:** Seed Catalogs are arriving. Planning for gardening and animal husbandry begins. In January they will meet to look at catalogs (hatchery/nursery/etc). If you get catalogs and want to share them, or do a group order, discuss with others!

For now, Antonio has been officially deputized and will continue to publish until a Chronicler is selected.**

**Exchequer: We have approximately \$17,000 in the bank. Checks are going out for various things like Insurance. Domesday report is due this month. Numbers for Crown Tournament are in.**

**Property Master: Not much is being done right now due to weather.**

A motion to have Ronan purchase 300 servings lunch + 100 extra hamburgers + 100 extra hotdogs for approximately \$550 and sell them at Simple Day as a fundraiser for the Barony was raised and passed.**
