From the Archery Captain

Wednesday of Thanksgiving week is Archery Thanksgiving, so if you're interested in eating pizza and shooting things, hand an archer a few dollars and show up. People are still flinging pointy items downrange. We're coming into busy season on yurts, so people have been informed to check the Facebook groups regularly to see if we're open or not, and I'll do my best to transfer that information to the Webmaster so that the calendar on the website can be updated. I'm also in the process of figuring out where we can buy more target butts and/or what style we want to get. The grass mats that we've been using are completely falling apart at this point, and with BWTA on the horizon, they need to be replaced.

Sadly, the place in the US that was making them is still out of commission, so our options are to pay \$\$!! to import grass mats from the UK, or to figure out another solution. Some baronies in the area are using closed cell foam in frames they've built (which means we need to figure out a time/place to build them) and the 4H site that Shadowed Stars used for their investiture used flotation foam from a dock, which wasn't horrible either. We often have trouble with normal commercial targets, because they're built to take the weight of a compound bow and our recurves often just bounce arrows off of them until someone with a crossbow has broken them in for us. We'd like to avoid those as much as possible. I'm going to call the archery ranges in the area and see if they have any recommendations, but if anyone else has ideas, I'd love to hear those as well.

November Althing Minutes

Barony of Sternfeld - Althing - 11/19/2015

Administrative/Financial

Baronial Bylaws Revision - The revised Baronial Bylaws, as put together at the last Althing, were sent on to Kingdom for approval.

Financial Policy - A motion was made to pass the existing (as approved in 2015) financial policy again for 2016 with no changes. It was seconded and passed polling. This was done as there is a requirement in the Financial Policy that it be reviewed and reapproved each year.

2015 Budgets for Officers

- Discussion of each officer's budget occurred. Only officers where the budget changed are mentioned below.**
- Archery dropped budget to \$100.**
- Chatelaine requested a budget of \$300 for the office. This includes \$274 in earmarked funds earned from the Chatelaine auction at Simple Day.**
- Budget for the Chirurgeon was removed as the office no longer exists per society policy. Additionally, it was mentioned that we cannot provide a first aid kit at events as a group anymore. Individuals can in an unofficial capacity. Additionally, a reminder to current and future autocrats to make sure to include pickles and water etc in event budgets going forward as they sometimes came from this budget.**
- Equestrian is requesting \$100 for equipment next year, plus \$100 for insurance for 2017 practice site (to be paid at the end of 2016).**
- Rapier requests \$400.**
- Youth (non-combat) will receive \$100 - it was decided not to reduce this amount in order that it might encourage someone to step up and take the office, knowing they have some budget for activities.**
- All other offices request the same budget.**
- Total for the year \$2975 across all offices vs. \$3749 last year.**
- We will also need potentially up to \$2000 for fighter practice site 2016. (40 indoor weeks at \$50 a night). Actual amount spent will be less, unless it rains a ton in the summer and we are able to rent the gym every time it rains.**
- A motion was made to approve the 2016 budget with the changes mentioned above. The motion was seconded and passed first polling. Second polling will be held at the December Baronial Business Meeting.**

Regular Business

November Officer Reports can be found in the November issue of the Sternfeld Star.

-There was a lengthy discussion about the \$894 approved previously for archery targets. The vendor was not able to provide them due to flooding. Initially it appeared they'd be getting back up and running, but they are not. Working on getting refunded for those, so that we can order different targets from another supplier. This is not related to 2015 budget. The expenditure was already approved back in 2014 and so will not need reapproved.

-We need to pay 2016 Equestrian insurance before 2016 starts - \$100 polling passed. Because the amount is \$100 or less, no second polling required. The amount will be included in each year's budget (for the following year's insurance) going forward.

Simple Day - July 2016. After some discussion, the Bid passed 2nd polling. Congrats to Moira and Torquil.

St. Timothy's Rental Donation for 2015. We use St. Timothy's for about 90 minutes each month for business meeting, and also once a quarter for Costumer's group, as well as at other times. We typically donate \$300 a year. A motion was made to make a \$300 donation again this year. Motion was seconded and passed first polling, second polling will be in December.

The Exchequer states we have \$14,571.48 in the bank currently.
