Barony of Sternfeld Business Meeting Minutes for 10/15/2015

Baronial Report - Baronial Storage was cleaned out.

Great Officers and Their Deputies

Seneschal - We will not be having a normal business meeting next month - instead we'll be having an Althing the same day (11/19). No new business - only Althing business (budget, 2016 planning, financial policy changes if any, etc) and second pollings on existing business. Meeting will start at 6:45. Bring your dinner.
