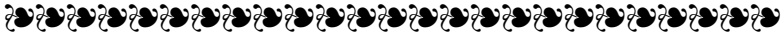

Seneschal report -

- Local seneschals have to read contract (ie site) for events.
- Kingdom seneschals must read for kingdom events.
- If you are planning to steward an event at a place not used in the last few years you will need to submit to seneschal early to allow for submission to society

Chronicler

-Moira found there is no longer a required class for chronicler. She will be warranted ASAP.

Webminister

- Ellbrig has been doing website updates while Torquil is at Pennsic. Please message if anything should be added.

Exchequer's report -

-We have money, simple day was very profitable. A few outstanding bills need clarified. Guestimate shows about \$4,000 profit. Lunch made a lot of profit. It is encouraged we continue to provide our own lunches.

-Exchequer's pop up was loaned to 50 year and blown away. SCA at event is not allowed to reimburse personal loaned property in event of loss or damage. Loan is at their own risk.

Property- We still have stuff and a way to get it around. The wheel hub on the trailer came apart during the trip to Pennsic. Every 4 years tires and spare should be repaired. Trailer is due for yearly maintenance. A mechanic will go over the rest. The fender on that side came off and is missing. There was no damage to the truck. Rose did an outstanding job having the experience, skills and equipment to keep this catastrophic event from causing serious harm.

Camp Sternfeld is looking for fundraisers for camp improvements. The goal to raise around more wish lists and estimates to follow. Starting goal of \$200 for sinks. The cost will be higher for showers.

Armored Marshal - Fighters are still fighting.

Rapier Marshal - Fighters are still fighting.

Pennsic report - No Sternfelders went to hospital this year. Yay us! First time in 6 years.

Archery- 8/31 next date

Equestrian - We will be able to continue practices through this year. Next is Sept 11th, Sunday, at 3 PM Mounted archery- Mounted war games will be Labor Day weekend near Ft Wayne.

-Nothing new, Seneschal still needs to read all of every contract and sign them. They cannot defer to someone else.

- The merger with Afonlyn will be complete once they transfer the back account balance.

- We usually have some demos this time of the year.

Schools also start contacting us for that this time of the year.

- Chatelaine - New chatelaine. We need the change of officer form signed.

- Herald - Nothing new

- Chronicler - Please send me reports. I will be publishing the Aug / Sept Star!

- Webminister - Wants to shift to Ellbrig as soon as his next report is done.

- Exchequer - **OPEN!** We have money. We have \$15,152.19, after closing out Simple Day. She needs a deputy to take over the office. She can extend the warrant for a year, but really needs someone to train to take over. You need someone who is super detail oriented.
